Ltd., Manpur –South Sikkim, has submitted a proposal for establishment / operation of existing grain based Distillery (ENA/Rs 60 KLPD) and expansion (ENA/Rs 60 KLPD to 120 KLPD) and absolute Alcohol (30 KLPD) along with cogeneration power plant (3.5 MW). This project is covered under the ambit of Environment Impact Assessment Notification dated 14th September 2006 issued by Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India and thus Environmental Clearance is mandatory for the proposed project for which the unit has applied for, accordingly the public hearing has been fixed as per details given below:-
