Therefore notice is hereby given to all concerned persons, having a plausible stake in the environmental aspects of the project or activity and to provide response in writing or by participating in the Public Hearing to be conducted on 4th August 2022 Sikkim at 11.00AM onwards. Any person having plausible stake in the environmental aspects of the project or activity can submit their response before the hearing date which may be addressed to the Member Secretary, State Pollution Control Board – Sikkim, Department of Forest & Environment, Government of Sikkim, Deorali, Gangtok.
