Sub: Extension of Authorization for Generation, Collection, Storage & Transportation of Hazardous Waste granted under the provisions of Rule 6 of the Hazardous & Other Waste (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.

Under extraordinary situation of COVID-19 outbreak and declaration of lockdown in the state of Sikkim as a part of preventative measure thereof, Hazardous & Other wastes may be required to be handled and stored by occupiers for more than 90 days.

The Rule 3(21) defines the occupiers as “Occupier in relation to any factory or premises, means a person who has control over the affairs of the factory or the premises and includes in relation to any hazardous and other waste, the person in possession of the hazardous or other waste.”

Therefore in exercise of power under the provisions of Rule 21 Schedule VII and Rule 8 of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016, the State Pollution Control Board-Sikkim hereby extends the Authorisation for Generation, Collection, Storage & Transportation of Hazardous & Other wastes for a period of 90 (ninety) days from 31st March, 2021 to the occupiers defined in Rule 3(21).

This notice shall be void after 30th June, 2021.

However, during this period the occupier shall ensure environmentally safe and sound storage of hazardous & other waste generated in their premises as per the conditions stipulated in the earlier consent/authorisation.

Under extraordinary situation of COVID-19 outbreak and declaration of lockdown in the State of Sikkim as a part of preventative measure thereof, inspection of industrial units before the grant of consent cannot be conducted by State Pollution Control Board-Sikkim officials.

However, during this period the industrial units shall apply for online consent via Online Consent Monitoring & Management System (OCMMS) portal and also ensure compliance of all the conditions reflected in the consent issued earlier.
